Please try to respond to the questions below as accurately as possible, remembering to quantify pollutant volumes, concentrations and/or mass in the units specified.

1. Will your process generate wastewater?
 - a. If yes, how much each day (gallons)?
 - b. What's in it?
Pollutants present, measured in milligrams per liter or parts per million
 - c. Do you plan to treat and discharge?
 - d. If no, what will you do with it?
 - i. Recycle?
 - ii. Land apply?
 - iii. Discharge to a municipal wastewater treatment plant (POTW)?
2. How much water will you require for your processes and other uses (gallons/ day)?
 - a. Are there any special quality needs?
3. Will any of your processes result in the emission of air pollutants?
 - a. What pollutants are in the emissions?
 - b. What is the estimated quantity of each pollutant in **tons per year**?
 - c. What are the sources of these pollutants?
 - d. What types of air pollution controls are being proposed?
4. Will any of your processes result in the generation of hazardous wastes?
 - a. How much?
 - b. Is it a listed hazardous waste?
 - c. Is it a characteristic hazardous waste?
 - d. Do you plan to treat or store it?
5. What is the NAICS code for your industry?
